

NOTICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER.S DESIGNATED AGENT

AND  
PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CLAIMS OF COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

1. FOR PURPOSES OF TITLE 17, SECTION 512, OF THE UNITED STATES CODE HostGo.com is registered with the United States Copyright Office pursuant to the Digital Millennium Copyright Act. If you believe that your work has been copied in a way that constitutes copyright infringement by a HostGo.com customer ("the Customer"), you ("the Complainant") must first provide HostGo.com's Copyright Agent with the following information in writing ("the Notification"):

1. an electronic or physical signature of the person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright interest that is allegedly infringed;
2. a description of the copyrighted work that you claim has been infringed; if multiple copyrighted works at a single site are covered by a single notification, then include a representative list of such works at that site;
3. a description of where the material that you claim is infringing is located on the site sufficient to permit us to locate the allegedly infringing material;
4. your address, telephone number, and email address;
5. a statement that you have a good faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law;
6. a statement by you, made under penalty of perjury, that the above information in your Notice is accurate and that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on the copyright owner's behalf.

Upon receipt of the written Notification containing the above information by the Complainant, and only upon receiving such Notification, HostGo.com will:

7. Remove or disable access to the material that is alleged to be infringing;
8. Forward the written notification to the alleged infringer ("the Customer");
9. Take reasonable steps to promptly notify the Customer that it has removed or disabled access to the material. In response, the Customer may send a "Counter-Notification" to HostGo.com. To be effective, the Counter-Notification must be in writing and include the following information:
10. The Customer's physical or electronic signature;
11. Identification of the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled and the location at which the material appeared before it was removed or access to it was disabled;
12. A statement under penalty of perjury that the Customer has a good faith belief that the material was removed or disabled as a result of a mistake or misidentification of the material to be removed or disabled;
13. The Customer's name, address, and telephone number, and a statement that the Customer consents to the jurisdiction of the Federal District Court in which the address is located, or if the Customer is outside the United States, for any judicial district in which HostGo.com may be found, and that the Customer will accept service of process from the person or his agent who provided the original Notification.

Upon receipt of the written Counter-Notification containing the above information by the Customer, and only upon receiving such Counter-Notification, HostGo.com will:

14. Provide the Complainant with a copy of the Counter-Notification;

15. Inform the Complaining Party that it will replace the removed material or cease disabling access to it within ten (10) business days ;

16. Replace the removed material or cease disabling access to the material within ten (10) to fourteen (14) business days following receipt of the Counter-Notification, provided HostGo.com's Copyright Agent has not received notice from the Complaining Party that an action has been filed seeking a court order to restrain the Customer from engaging in infringing activity relating to the material referenced in the Notification.
